

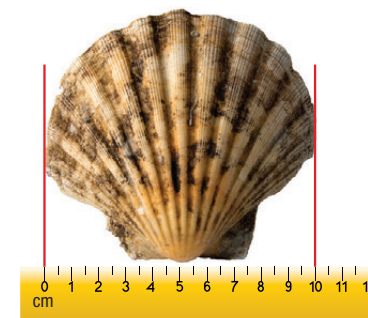
MEASURING KAIMOANA

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There is a rule that says that scallops must be 10 cm wide before you can take them from the sea.

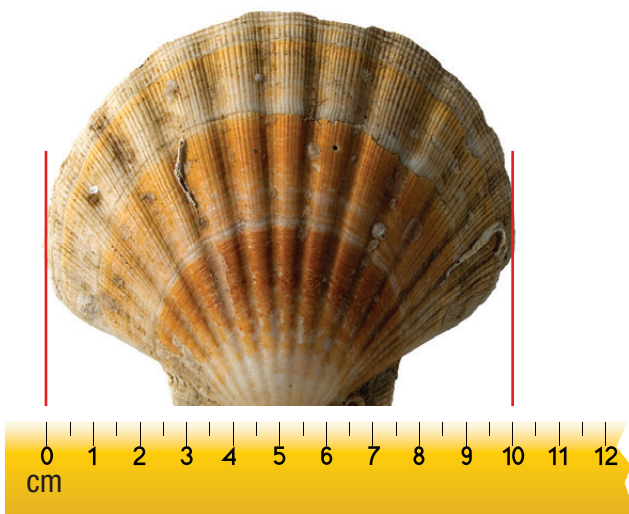
Which scallops are big enough to take?

Scallops should be measured at the **widest part** of the shell.

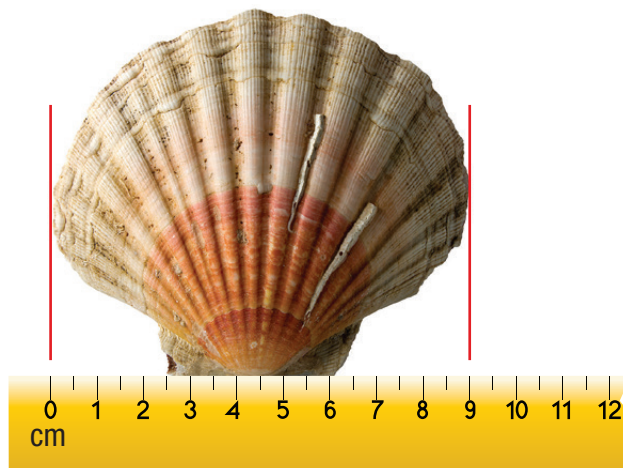


A scallop must be at **least 10cm wide** to take.

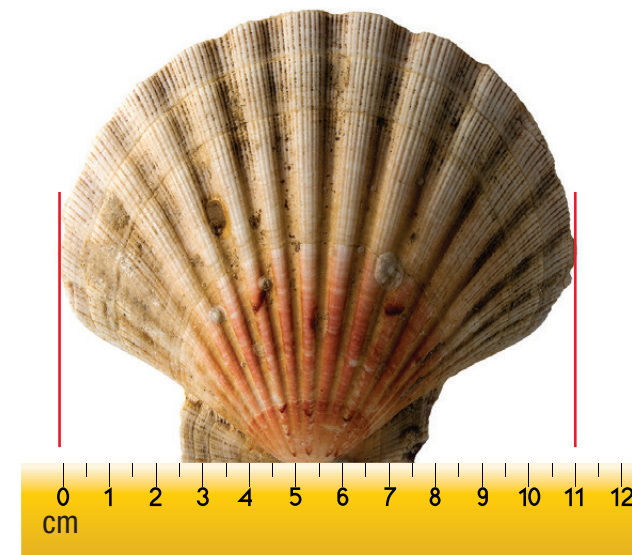
Scallop 1

Scallop 3

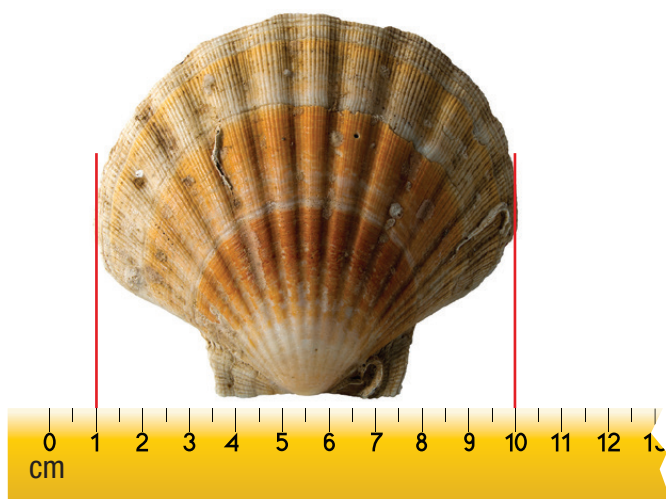

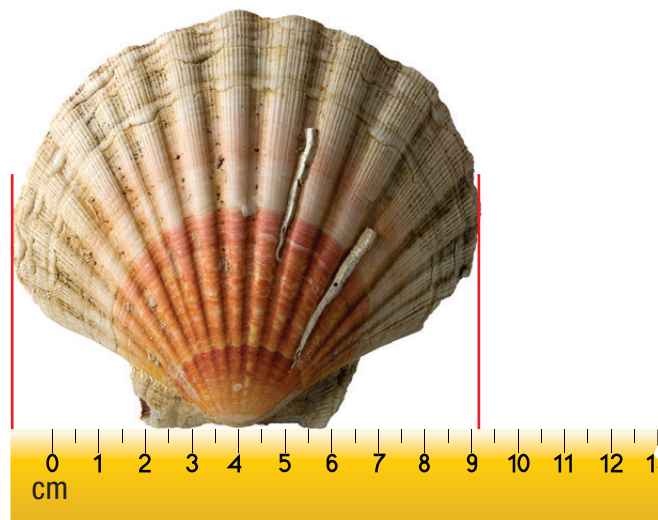

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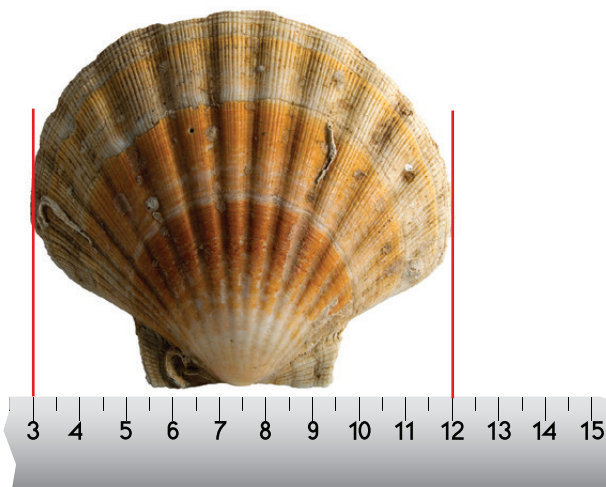
The people gathering kaimoana have only got a broken ruler to measure the scallops.
