

5 MAKE A CLOCK FACE

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- a photocopy of the clock face glued to, thick cardboard
- crayons or coloured pencils
- split pin
- scissors
- felt pens

- 1 **Write the digits 1-12** clearly on the clock face with felt pen.
(Copy a real clock if you need to.)
- 2 **Colour the left half** of the clock one colour, and the **right half** of the clock a different colour.
Do not colour over the numbers.
- 3 **Carefully cut** out the clock face, the hour hand and the minute hand
- 4 **Poke** the split pin through the ends of both clock hands first and then through the centre of the clock face.
