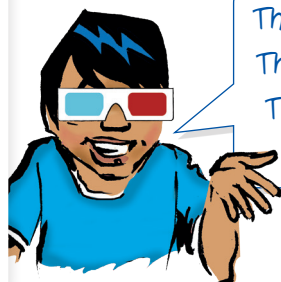


3 I SEE THE WORLD IN 3-D



- magazines or advertising flyers with 3-D images

- 1 Look for pictures in magazines or advertising flyers that are real-life examples of 3-D shapes.
- 2 Carefully mark the edges and vertices of the 3-D shape on the picture you have chosen.



This is a **2D** picture of the moon.
The moon is really a **3D sphere**.
The surface is curved so there are no vertices.

- 3 Sort the pictures into groups according to their shape and label each group.

Your teacher may ask you to share the pictures you have found with the class, or add your pictures to one big display with all the 3-D shapes your class have found.



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
