

6 TIDY MY DESK

- large (A3+) piece of paper with compass rose drawn in one corner, 8-10 small objects from students' desks or around the classroom (e.g. pencil, notebook, ruler, eraser, felt pens, dice, counter...)

- 1 Arrange the objects on the piece of paper - this is the 'desk'.
Objects should be in straight lines, directly beside, above, or below each other.
- 2 The player who put the first item on the paper starts.
- 3 Give the person on your **right** an instruction to **remove** an item from the 'desk' using a compass direction.
You must **not** say the name of the item that is being removed.

For example

Please remove the first item that is **North** of the pen.



- a If the player removes the correct item, they place it in front of them.
 - b If the player does **not** remove the correct item, the item is returned to the desk.
- 4 The player who was asked to remove an item has their turn to "tidy the desk" by removing an item, whether they kept an item or not.
 - 5 Players take turns to give an instruction until all the items are removed.
 - 6 The player with the most items is the winner.
They can arrange the items on the desk for the next round.
