

MAKING THE MOST OF WHAT WE KNOW

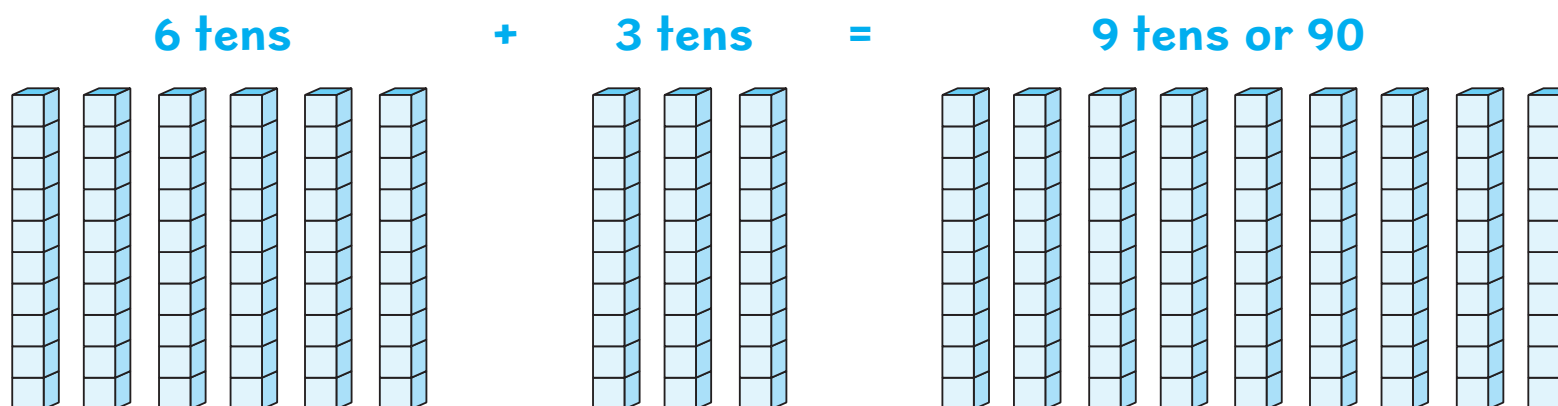
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We can use a fact we know to find the answer to other equations.

We can use $6 + 3 = 9$

to solve $60 + ? = 90$

because



$$60 + 30 = 90$$

We can use $6 + 3 = 9$

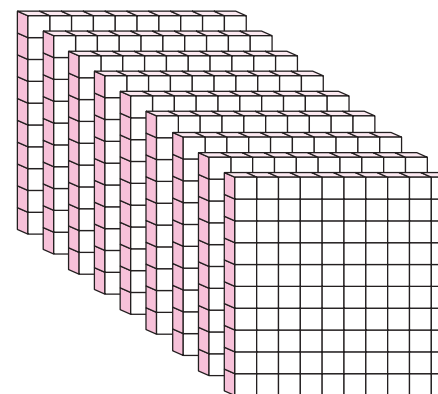
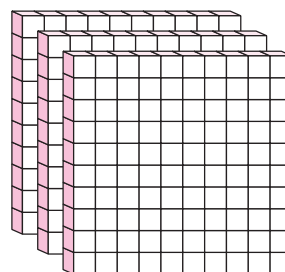
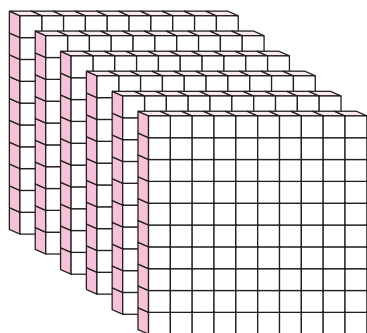
to solve $600 + ? = 900$

+ 3 hundreds =

9 hundreds or 900
