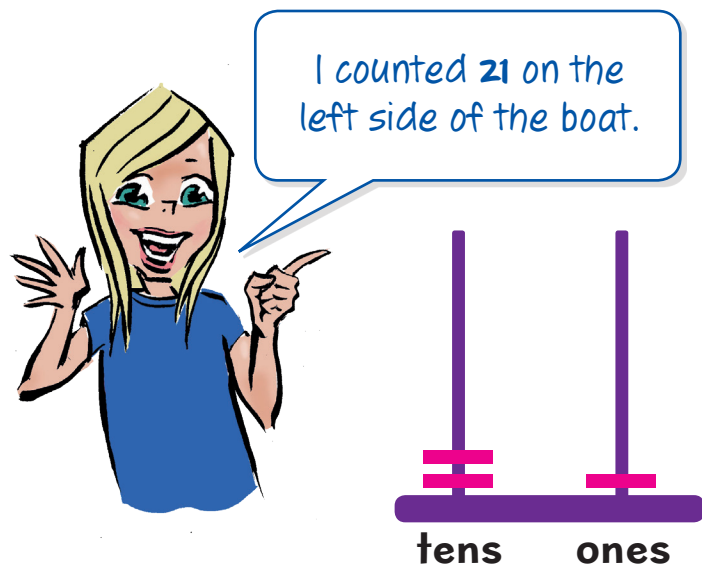


DOLPHIN WATCH

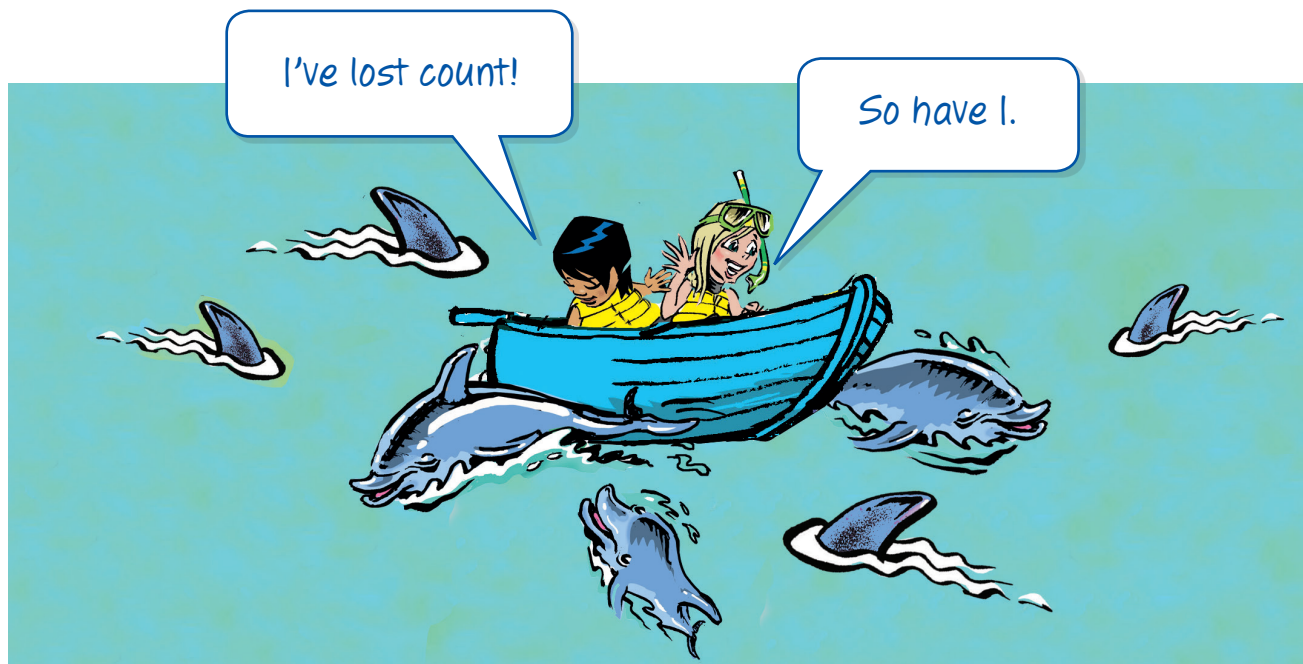


- 1 **a** How might Max finish his explanation?
