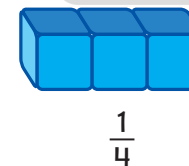
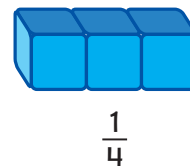
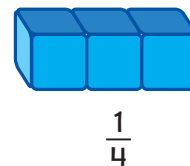
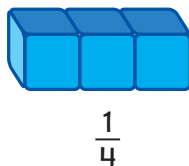


2 MULTILINK CUBES

Example

Max put 12 cubes into 4 equal groups.

Each group is $\frac{1}{4}$ of the 12 cubes.



$\frac{1}{4}$ of 12 is 3 because,
 $3 + 3 + 3 + 3 = 12$.
