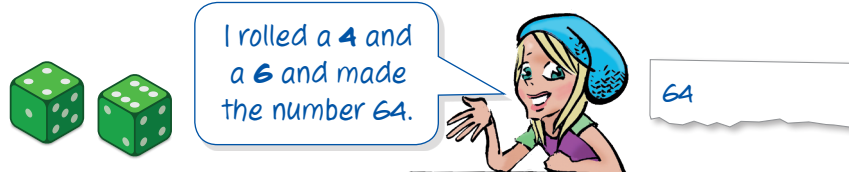


1 Game

10 and 100 Bingo

- 1 Each player creates a Bingo Card.
- 2 Shuffle the 10 and 100 cards and place them face down in the middle of the table.
- 3 Take turns to roll the two dice and make a 2-digit number with the numbers rolled. Write down the number so everyone can see it.

Example Jess rolled 4 and 6 and made the number 64.



- 4 Turn over a 10 or 100 card from the middle pack. Both players multiply the number that was made in **step 3** by the number on this card.

Example Jess turned over a 10 card and wrote:

$$64 \times 10 = 640$$



- 5 If that hundreds or thousands number is on your Bingo Card, cover it with a counter.
- 6 The first player to cover a row or column on their Bingo Card is the winner. Swap Bingo Cards and play again.

Variation

Try playing in a small group rather than with a partner; one student could be nominated as the 'caller' to roll the dice and turn up the numbers 10 or 100 from the middle pile.
