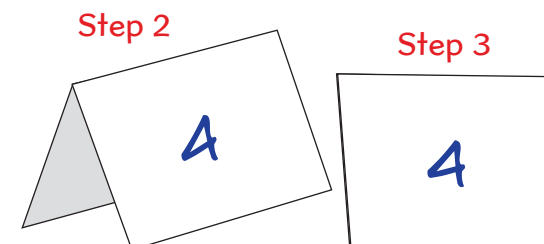
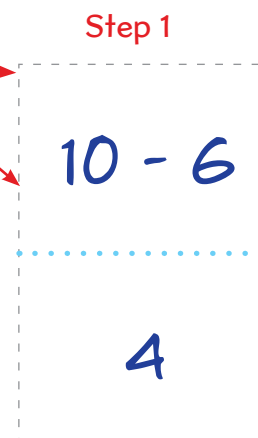


5 MAKE YOUR OWN 'FLASH CARDS'



• 10 flash cards for each player

- 1 **Cut** out each fact along the dashed line.
- 2 **Fold** the fact in half (backwards) along the dotted blue line.
- 3 **Glue** the folded surfaces together.
- 4 **Write** each fact you want to learn on one card.
The **question** on the top and the **answer** on the bottom.



You can play flash cards with a partner or by yourself.

Choose some facts you need to practise - (no more than 10 at once.)

5 This is how you 'Flash'

- a **Read** each equation. (If you are playing with a partner, they show you the equation as they read it out.)
- b **Say** the answer as quickly as you can.
- c **Check** on the back to see if you are correct.

6 If you were **correct** and knew the answer **without working it out**, place it in a pile on your **right**.
If you were **wrong** or **needed to work the answer out**, place it in a pile on your **left**.

8 **Practise** all the facts from the pile on your **left**.

You could: Write the fact in four different colours.

Say or write the whole family of facts down.

9 Pick up all the cards that were on your left and '**flash**' again.

10 Keep going until you finish with **all the cards on your right**.

Challenge yourself and see if you **know** the whole pile now.
