

1 Game

Big, bigger, biggest!

- 1 The first person to roll a **6** on the die starts.
- 2 Each player rolls the die or turns over a card and writes their digit down. (*Do this three times*).
- 3 When each player has three digits, they write down the biggest number they can make with their three digits.
- 4 The person with the biggest number wins a point.

Example



I threw a **5**, a **7** and a **2**.
The biggest number I can make is **752**.



Variations

- 1 The players can be asked to make the **smallest** number they can with three digits.
- 2 Players can roll the dice **four times** or choose four cards and make the biggest/smallest number possible.

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
