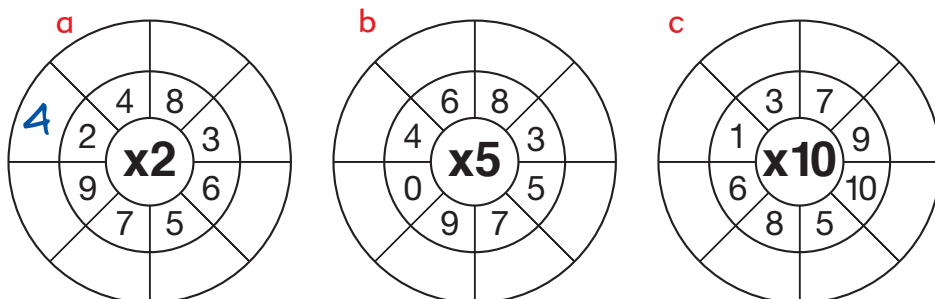


1 WHEELY GOOD AT MULTIPLICATION

One has been done for you



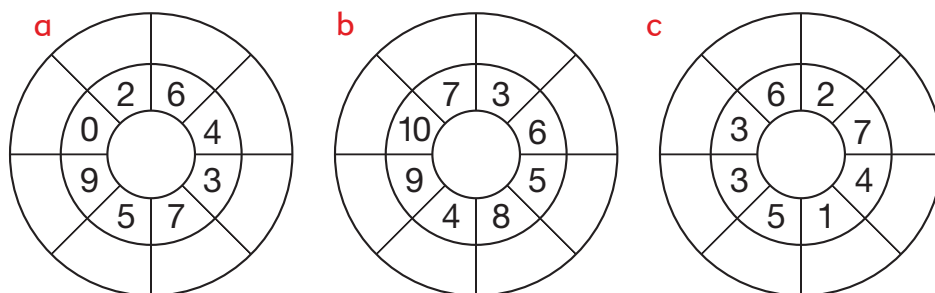
Use a calculator or times table list to mark your answers.

Example



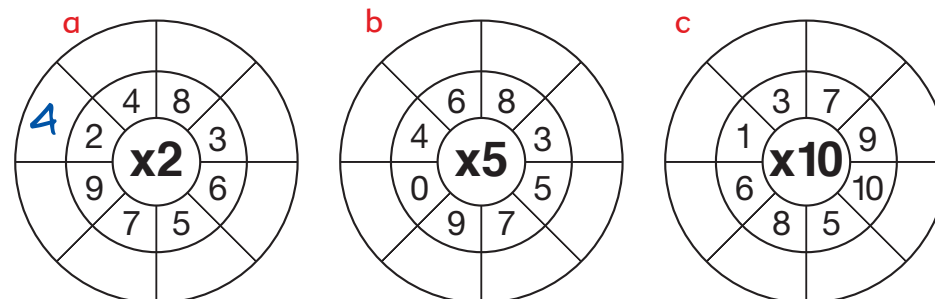
I got 5×2 wrong
