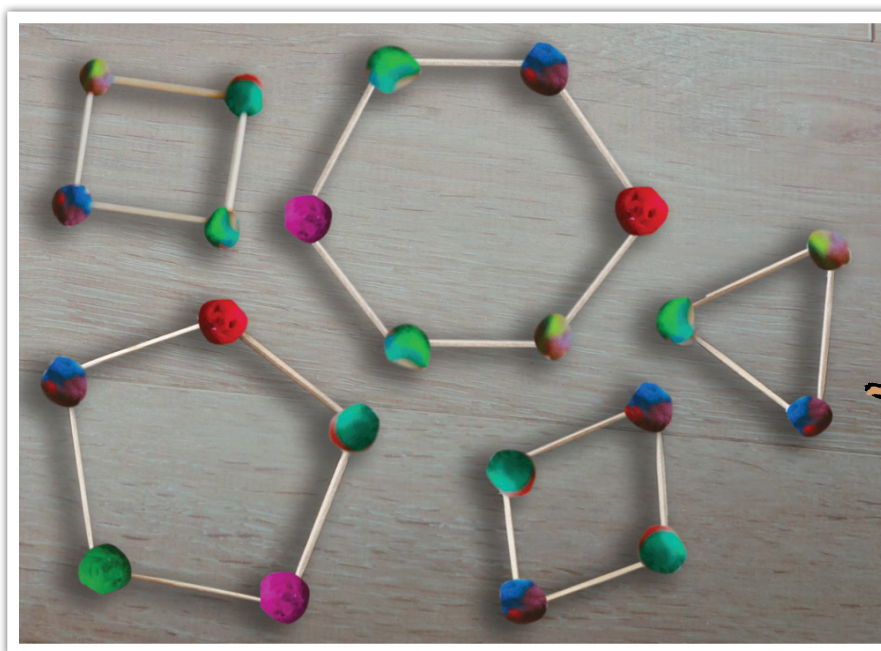
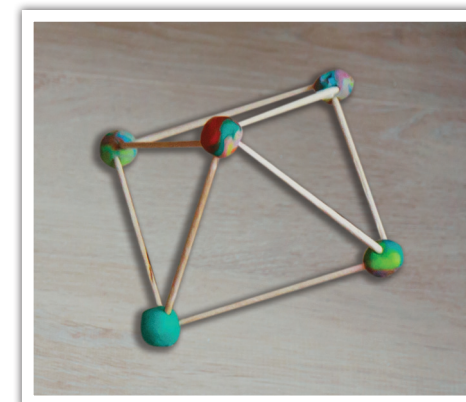
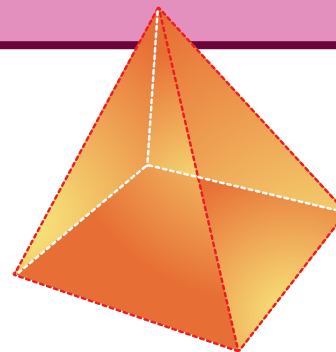


2-D IN 3-D
