Zoom in and out again.

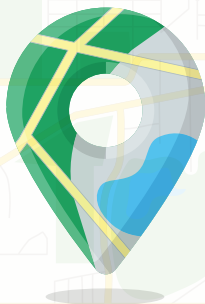
- 1 What do you recognise?
