Total our two numbers

- 1 Two students each write a 2-digit number on a piece of paper **without** looking at what the other student has written.
They become the **umpires**.
- 2 Together they hold the two pieces of paper, so everyone can see the numbers they have written.
- 3 The rest of the group or class add the numbers as quickly as they can and write their answer down.
- 4 Students who finish and want to share their answer, put their hands on their heads and wait.
