- 4 The person to the left tries to put down a card beside this card so the sides match.

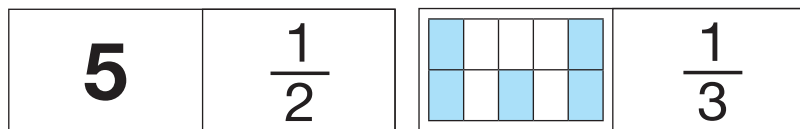
Example

- 6 The person who puts down all their cards first is the winner.

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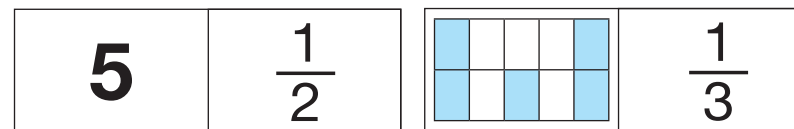
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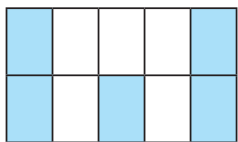
