

6 BUILD ME A WALL

Sit back to back with your partner.
Using the Cuisenaire rods each player builds a wall that the other player is not allowed to see.

- The wall must have **straight sides**.
- Every rod in a row must be the **same colour**.
- The wall must be at least **three rows high**.
- Each row must have **smaller** rods than the row below it.

- 1 The first player to finish their wall is also the first to tell their partner how to build a copy of that wall.

Rules

- Your partner **cannot look** at what you have built.
- You can say the colour of the rod(s) used for the **bottom** row.
- You **cannot say** the colour of any other rods used to build your wall.
- You must use a **fraction** in each instruction.

Take a dark green rod for the base.
Put two rods that are $\frac{1}{2}$ the length of the base on top...



- 2 Check your partner's wall.
Take a point for each correctly completed row.
- 3 Swap and follow instructions to build your partner's wall.

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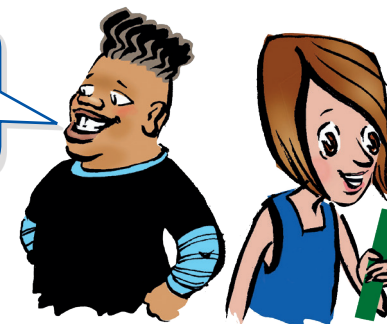
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
