Karl the kiwi dog is very good at finding kiwi in the bush for the researchers.

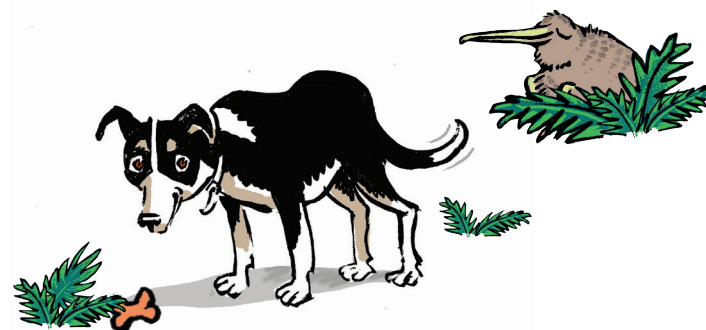
The researcher compares to see whether the kiwis are larger, smaller or the same size.

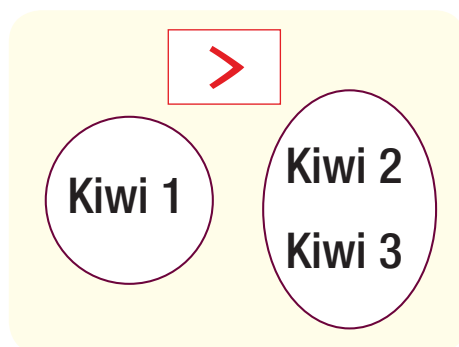

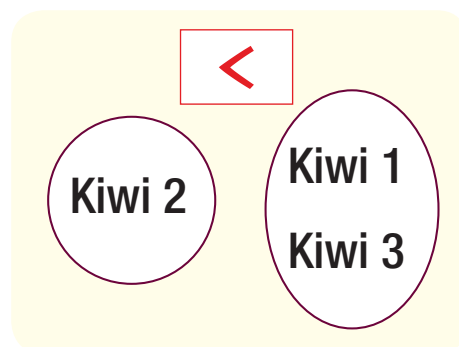
- 2 Put one of these symbols (< or >) in the box above the last diagram.

Draw arrows to finish each diagram and use them to decide which of the kiwi is the adult male, adult female and the young kiwi.

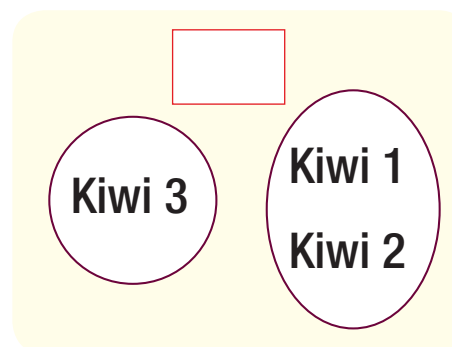
Height
