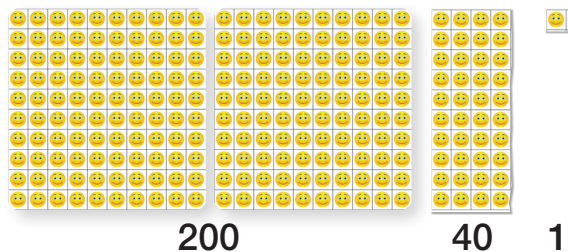


1 TWO HUNDRED AND FORTY-ONE

You could use place value blocks, water in measuring containers or your own drawings to show 241 in other ways.

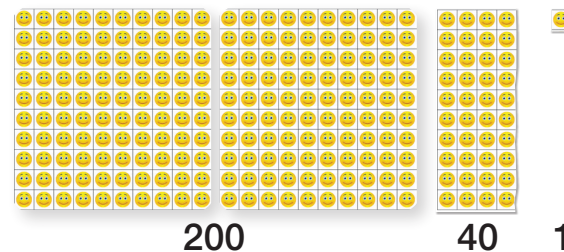
