

**2 Game**

- 2 clear yellow counters
- 12 counters of a different colour for each player

**1** Both players drop a counter onto the board. The player whose counter lands on the smallest number starts.

**2** This player places **2 yellow counters** on numbers in the **orange strip** and **adds** the two numbers together.

If the answer is correct, the player puts one of their counters on the answer in one of the blue squares.

| <b>4</b> | 18 | 6        | 14 | 10 | 16 | 11 | 4  | 10 |

You **cannot** have two counters on the same **blue** square.

**3** Take turns to repeat step two but on each turn move **one** of the **yellow counters** in the **orange strip** to a different number.

You **can** have two yellow counters on the same **orange** square.

**4** If a player makes a total which is not in an empty square they cannot put a counter down. It is the next player's turn.

**5** The winner is the first player to get **four of their own counters in a row or column**.

**Gotcha!**
