All of the letters must go in a square.

The letters in square(s)

- a A2, C3 and B2 have just one horizontal line of symmetry.
- b A3 and C1 have just one vertical line of symmetry.
- c A1 and B1 have no lines of symmetry.
- d B3 has two lines of symmetry.
- e A1, B1 and C1 are next to each other in the alphabet.
- f A3 and C1 are the furthest apart in the alphabet.
- g A3 and A2 are next to each other in the alphabet.
- h C3 is the same letter as the letter part of its grid reference.
