How much more does she need to pay?

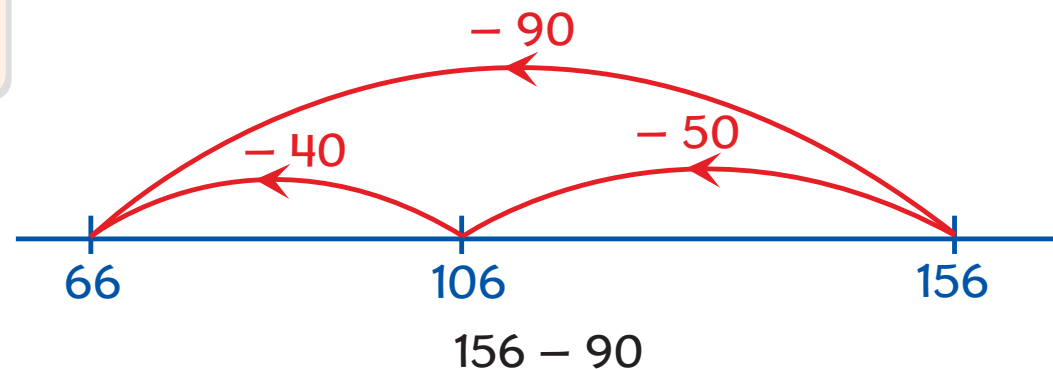
## AT THE VET CONTINUED

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$$156 - 88 = ?$$

Make 88 into the tidy number 90 by **adding 2**.



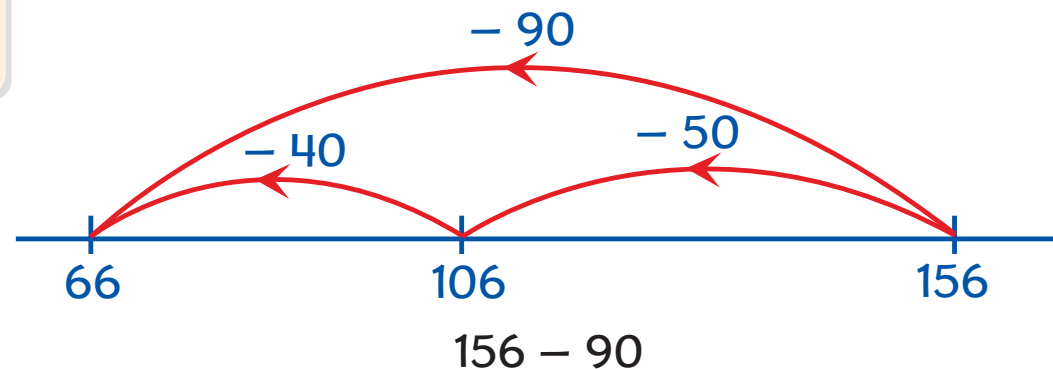
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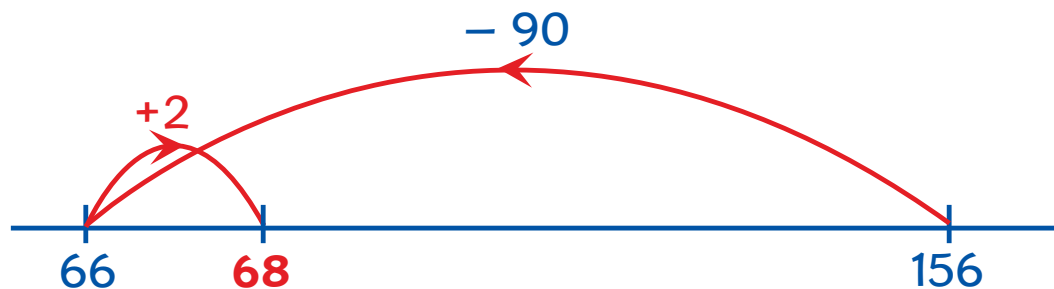
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$$156 - 88 = ?$$

Make 88 into the tidy number 90 by **adding 2**.



Because 2 more than needed were subtracted, they must be added back, so **add 2** to the answer.



$$\begin{aligned} 156 - 88 &= 156 - 90 + 2 \\ &= 66 + 2 \\ &= 68 \end{aligned}$$

Jess has **\$68** more to pay.

## AT THE VET CONTINUED

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**or**       $156 - 88 = ?$

$$156 - 88 = 156 - 90 + 2$$
$$= 15 \text{ tens} + 6 \text{ ones} - 9 \text{ tens} + 2 \text{ ones}$$

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**or**       $156 - 88 = ?$

$$\begin{aligned} 156 - 88 &= 156 - 90 + 2 \\ &= 15 \text{ tens} + 6 \text{ ones} - 9 \text{ tens} + 2 \text{ ones} \\ &= 6 \text{ tens} + 8 \text{ ones} \\ &= \mathbf{68} \end{aligned}$$
