

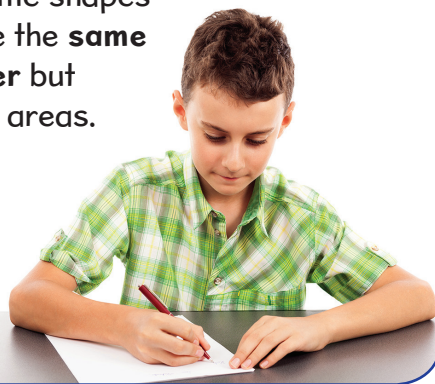
4 WHAT CAN YOU DRAW?

- 2 Draw a shape in which the number for the **area** is twice the number for the perimeter.
- 3 Draw any shape. Now change the shape so that the **perimeter** gets larger but the area gets smaller.
- 4 Draw any shape. Now change your shape so that the **area** of your shape gets larger but the perimeter gets smaller.
- 5 Draw some shapes that have the **same area** but different perimeters.
- 6 Draw some shapes that have the **same perimeter** but different areas.



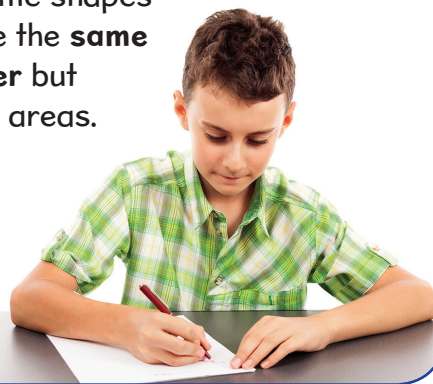
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
