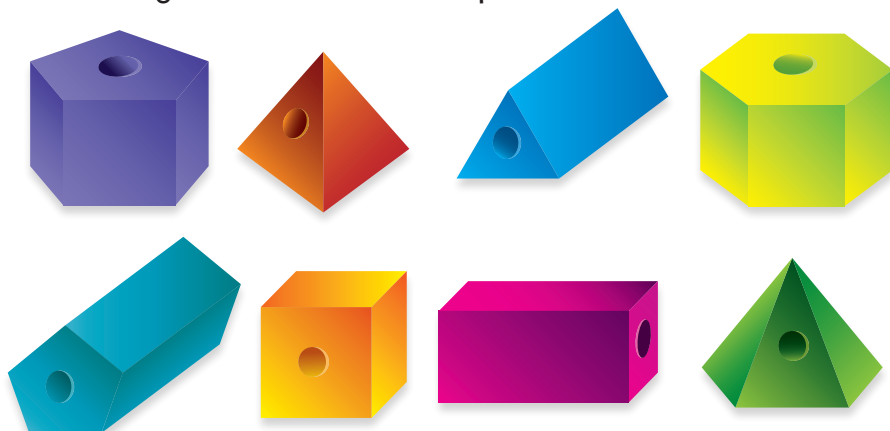


4 MAKING A NECKLACE

Ting made coloured shapes out of plastic, drilled holes through them and then strung them together to make necklaces.

She made eight beads in these shapes.



She wanted to make a necklace that had the beads with the same shaped faces next to one another.

For example *A triangular face of one bead was next to a triangular face of another bead.*

- Find at least two ways that Ting could arrange the beads in a circle for her necklace. Make sure that the last and the first beads also have matching faces next to each other.
- Write the names of the bead shapes in the order that they need to be put in her necklace.

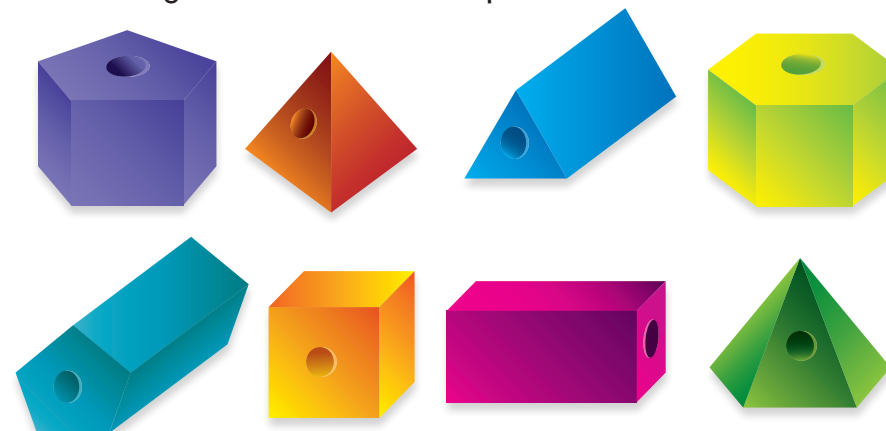
Challenge
