What was the total fare paid by the sixteen people?
- 5** A house near the finish line of the rowing course could be hired for \$540 for the day.
A group of people each paid \$90 to hire it.
How many were in the group?
- 6** Of the 116 people who hired canoes to follow the rowing teams half were students and 27 were adult males.
The rest were adult females.
How many adult females hired canoes?
