Example

E, (pressed – instead of $\times$), gives the wrong answer 6.

Box A

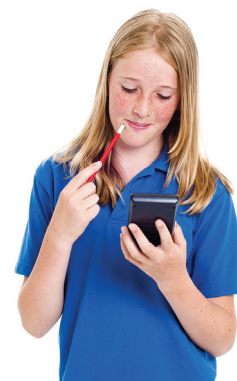
- E** Pressed – instead of $\times$
- T** Pressed 65 instead of 56
- M** Forgot to press =
- I** Pressed + instead of $\times$
- S** Reversed last 2 digits of answer
- A** Pressed 13 instead of 31
- R** Reversed middle 2 digits of answer
- F** Pressed $\div$ instead of $\times$

Box B

- 1** $56 \times 31 = 1.8064516$
- 2** $56 \times 31 = 2015$
- 3** $56 \times 31 = 1763$
- 4** $56 \times 31 = 31$
- 5** $56 \times 31 = 1376$
- 6** $56 \times 31 = 25$
- 7** $56 \times 31 = 728$
- 8** $56 \times 31 = 87$

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
