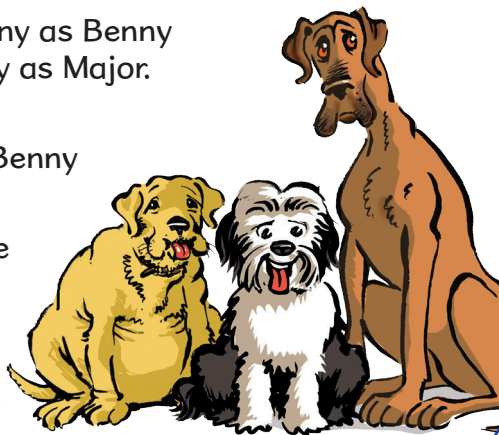


1 THREE DOGS

- b If the dogs got the same number of biscuits every day, how many biscuits did each dog get each week?



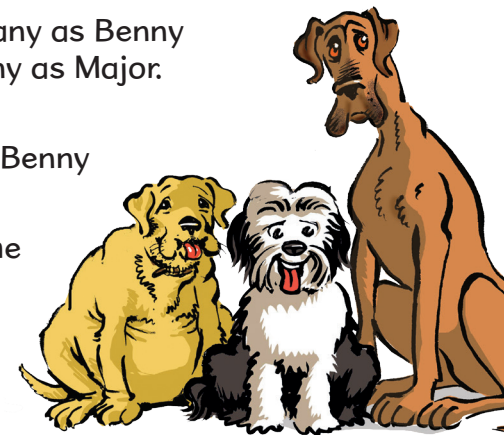
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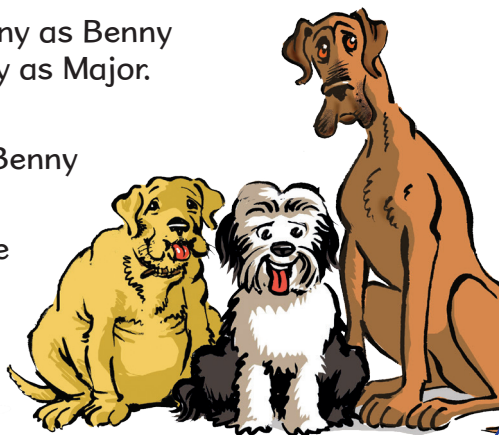
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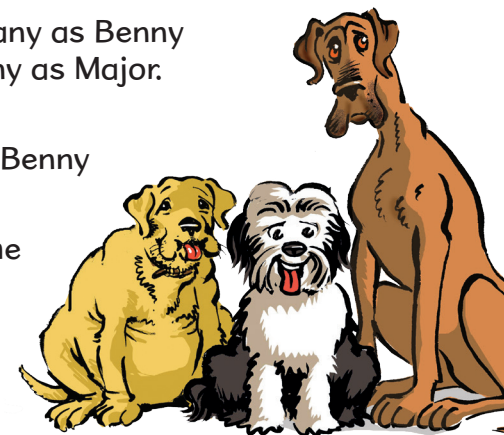
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
