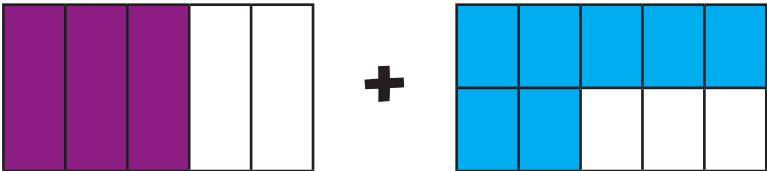


CHOP IT UP

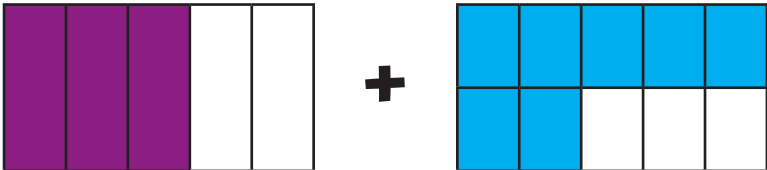
$$\frac{3}{5} + \frac{7}{10} =$$
