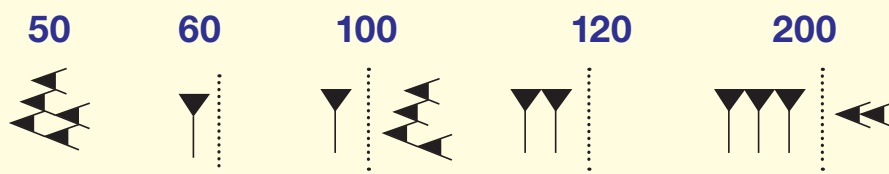
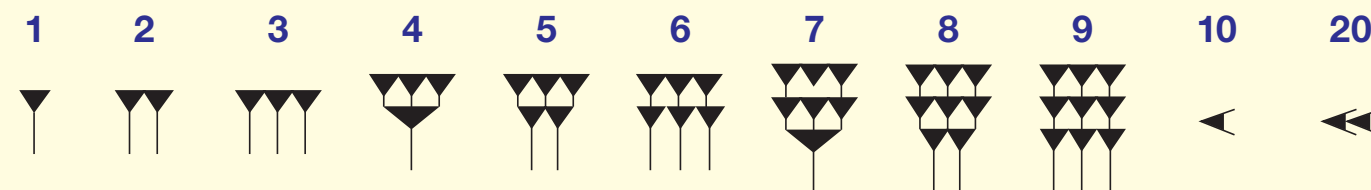
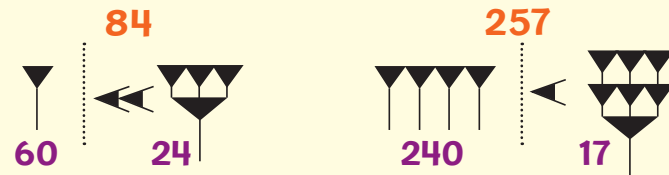


- The ancient **Babylonians** developed a number system that was not based on tens. This shows how some numbers were written.
