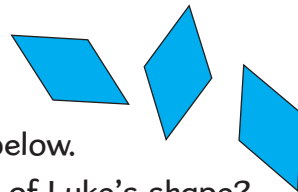


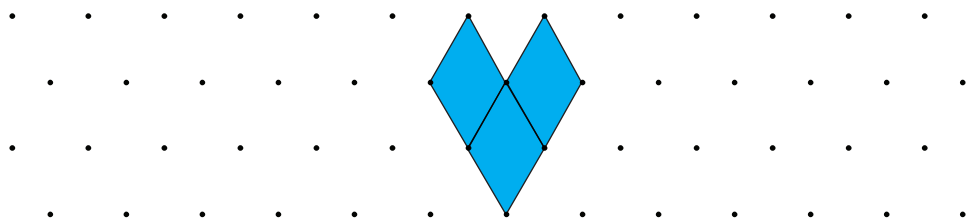

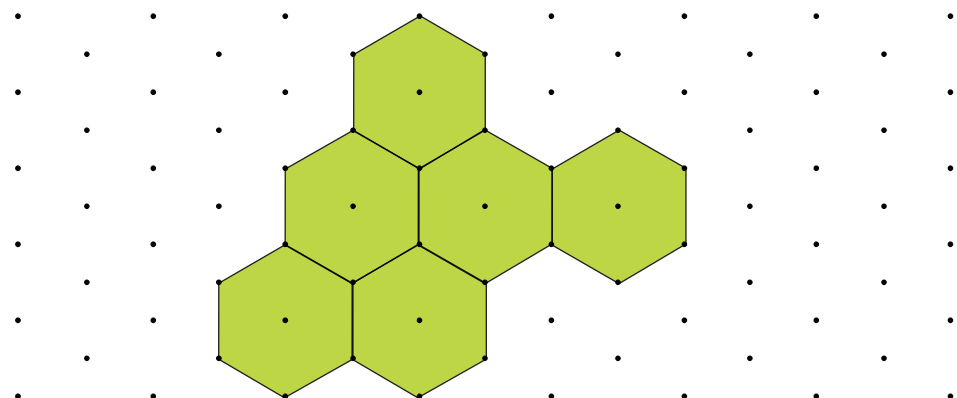
• 1 cm triangle

b Draw a shape made from Luke's 3 tiles which has a larger perimeter than Luke's shape.

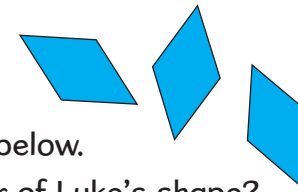


- 2 a What is the perimeter of this shape?

c Draw another shape made from 6 hexagons which has a **larger** perimeter.

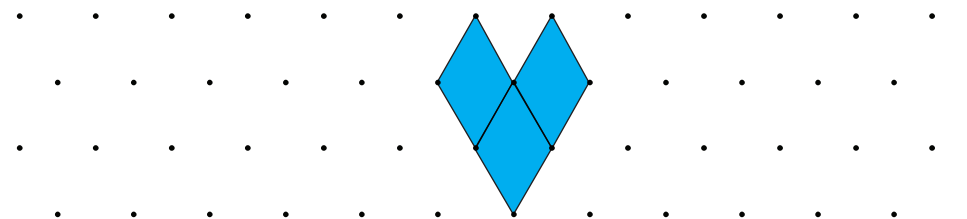

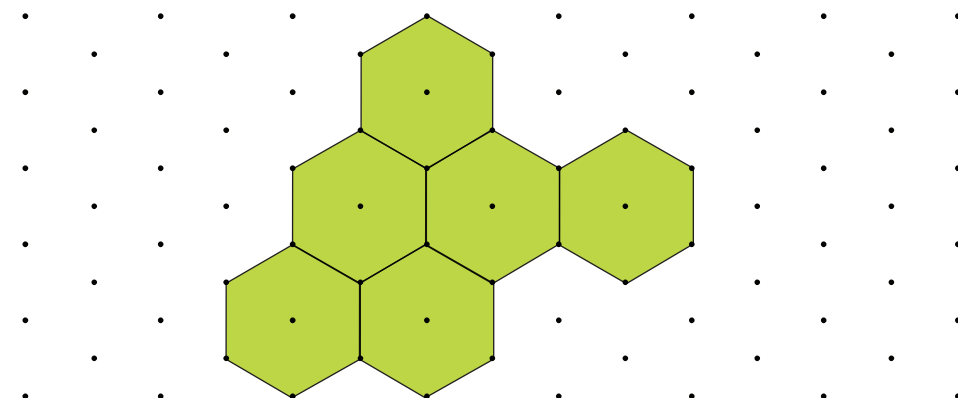
