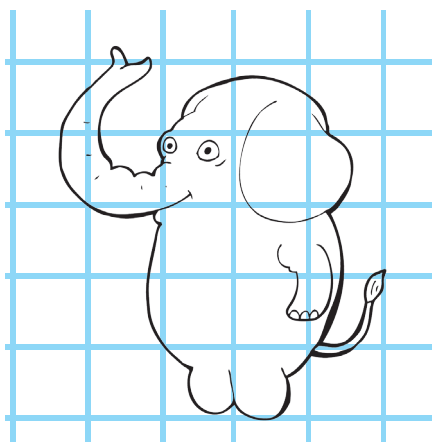
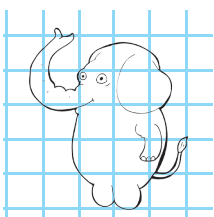
- 1 Projectors and binoculars enlarge images and objects.

- c Draw the picture square by square onto a **larger** grid. If the larger grid is in pencil you can rub it out when you have finished.

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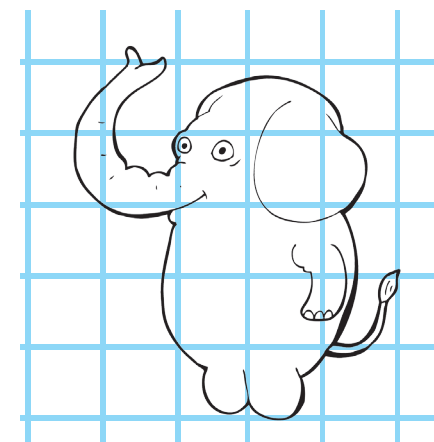
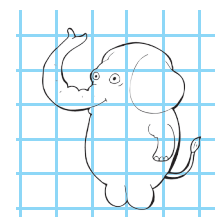
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
