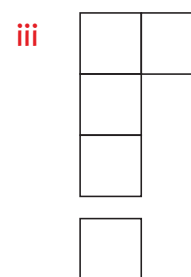
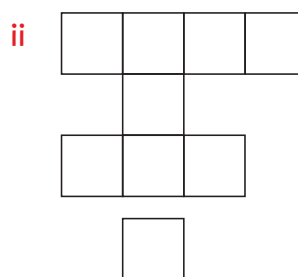
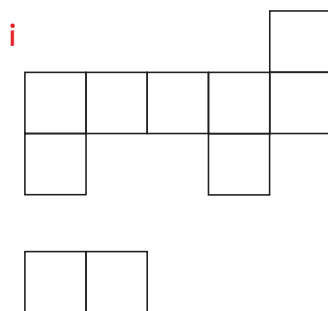

- b Draw two shapes of your own that could fit together to form symmetrical patterns. Give your shapes to a your partner to see if they can make your patterns.



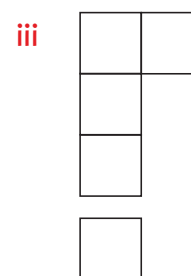
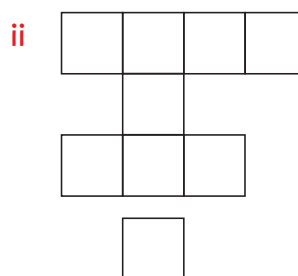
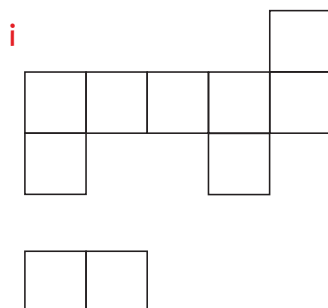
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
