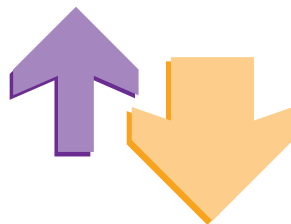


2 Game

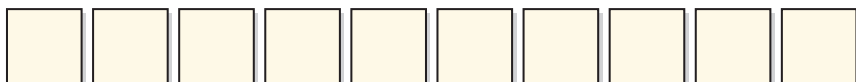


- ten cards numbered 1 to 10

Ups and downs



- 1 Shuffle the cards.
- 2 Place them face down in a line.



- 3 Turn over the first card in the line.
- 4 **Player 1** guesses whether the next card in the line will be higher or lower than the first card turned over.
- 5 The second card is turned over.
Player 1 gets 1 point if the guess was right.
- 6 Take turns and repeat **steps 4 and 5** for the rest of the cards in the line.
- 7 Stop when all the cards are turned over.
- 8 Play the game four times.
The player with the most points wins.

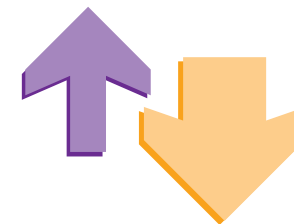
Is this a fair game?
