

3 WRITE A RIDDLE

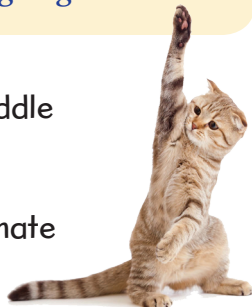
This is a riddle.
