How many blocks did she sell?
- 4 Aroha pays \$4 each week for delivery of her produce.
How much does she pay every six weeks?
- 5 How many of each of these vegetables did she sell altogether?
 - i 5 bags of carrots with 40 carrots in each bag
 - ii 8 bunches of leeks with 50 leeks in each bunch
 - iii 500 packets with 6 tomatoes in each packet
 - iv 20 boxes with 30 cauliflowers in each box
 - v 50 sacks with 200 potatoes in each sack
 - vi 40 bags with 30 kumara in each bag
