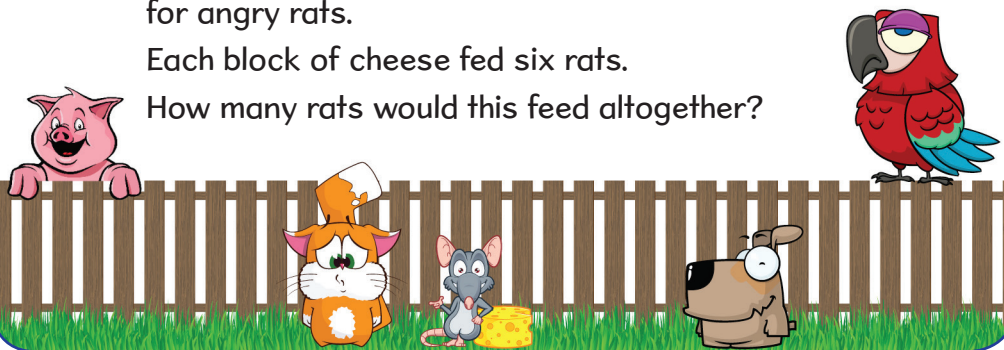

How many rats would this feed altogether?

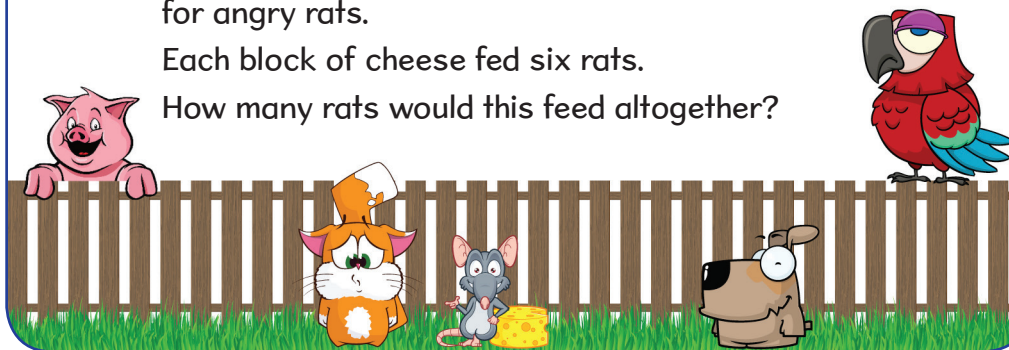
