

1 FRACTION DOMINOES GAME



fraction domino cards



- 1 Sit in a circle.
- 2 Give three cards to each player. Put the rest face down in a pile.
- 3 Choose someone to start.
- 4 This person puts down one of their cards.
- 5 The person on their left tries to put down a card next to it so the sides match (like dominoes).

Example Mandy started.

She put down this card.



Rose was on her left.

She worked out that $\frac{1}{3}$ of 27 was 9.

She put down this card so that the $\frac{1}{3}$ of 27 and the 9 match.



- 6 If you cannot put down a card, you miss your turn but take a card from the pile.
- 7 The winner is the first person to put down all their cards.

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
