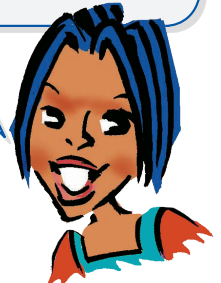




We are driving from Picton to Bluff to catch the ferry to Stewart Island. Mum hired a satellite navigator for the car.
