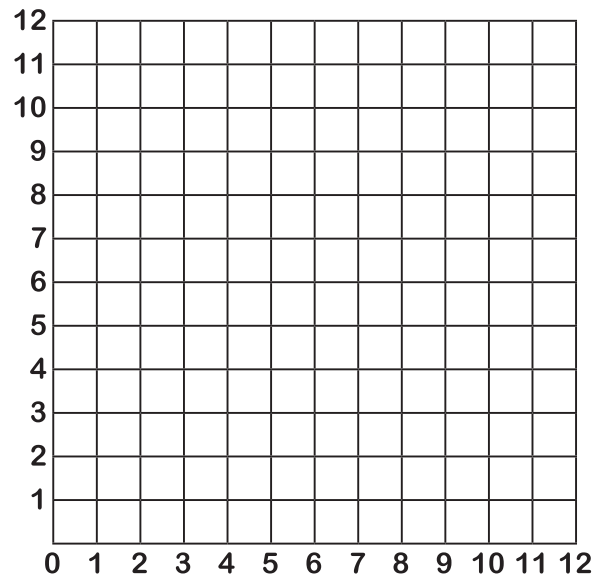




## WHAT'S MY PLACE?

1. Hold the ends of strings to build a grid on concrete or tarmac. Use 10 to 12 strings in each direction.
2. Draw along the strings with chalk and number along each axis of the grid 1, 2, 3 etc.

NOTE: You could make a permanent grid on plastic or other material that can then be used for other purposes.



3. Choose a leader.
4. The leader chooses five grid references and writes them down without showing them to the others.
5. Each student in the group stands at a grid reference of their choice.
6. The leader calls out the five grid references he or she wrote down.
7. Any students at the grid references that the leader called get five points.
8. All students move off the grid and **steps 4 to 7** are repeated with a different leader.
9. The winner is the student with the most points after each member of the group has had a turn as leader.
