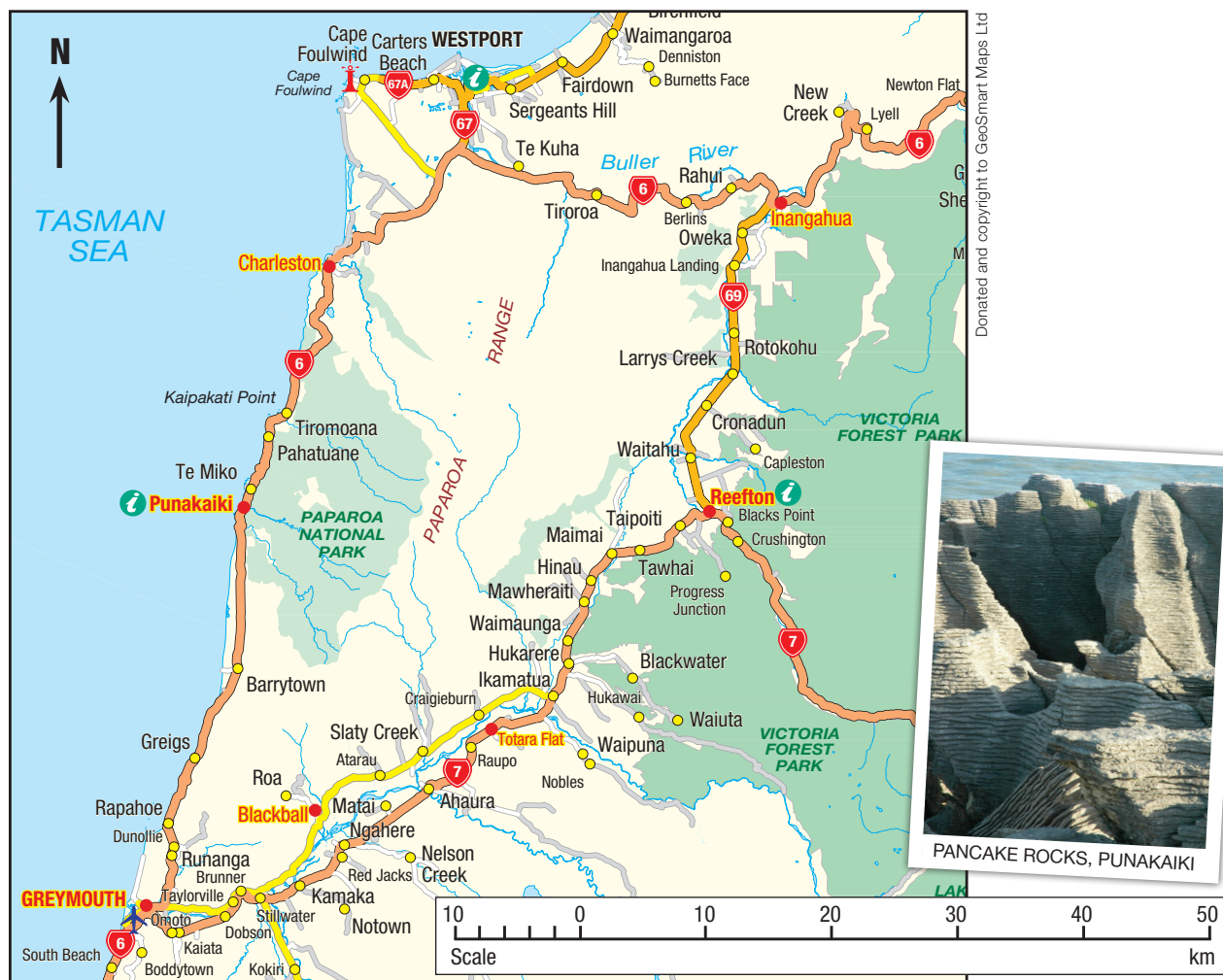


Chapter 17 – Activity 5 - Question 1
