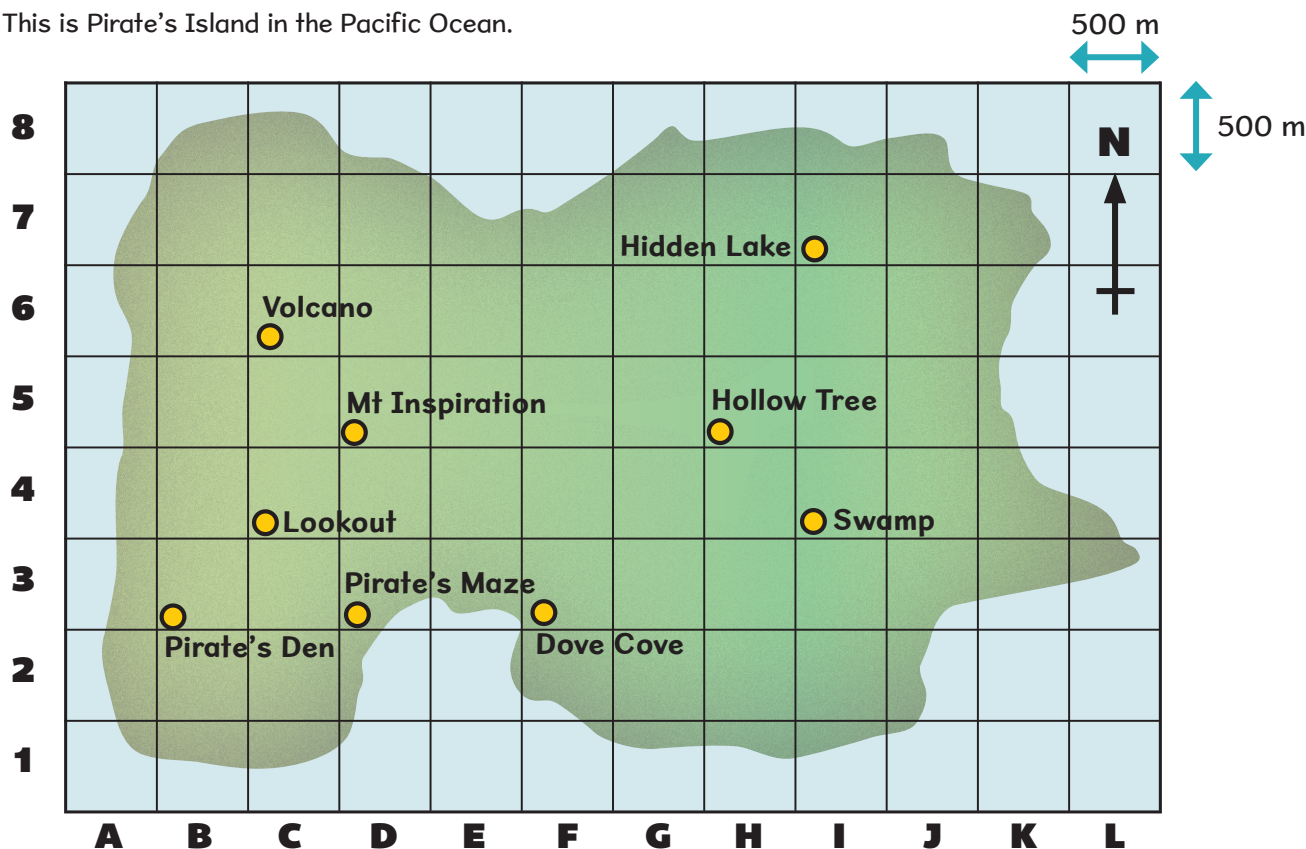


Chapter 18 – Activity 3 - Question 2

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2 This is Pirate's Island in the Pacific Ocean.



- Harry Cutlass was standing at the Pirate's Den and looking North East at something about 700 m away. What was it?
- One-eyed Jack walked 1 km North from the Hollow Tree. Then he walked 500 m East. Where did he end up?
- One-armed Jesse was told to start at the place in square F3 on the map and follow these directions to find the treasure.
Walk 1.5 km North, then 700 m North East, then $\frac{1}{2}$ km South, then 2.1 km South West, then 500 m North, then 2.5 km East.

Give the name of the place and the grid reference of where the treasure is buried.

- Three other pirates followed different directions. Which one reached the treasure?



One-eyed Jack
started at Hidden Lake and went 2.5 km West, then 1.4 km South West, then 3 km East, then 1.4 km South East.

Pegleg Pete
started at the Lookout and went 1.5 km North, then 1500 m East, then 2.1 km South East.



Captain Hal
started at Dove Cove and went 1.5 km East, then 2.1 km North West, then 1.4 km South East, then 500 m North.



- In **part d** change one distance or direction for each of the pirates who didn't reach the treasure to help them find it.
- Make up your own set of instructions to find the treasure. Start at the Volcano. Have at least four instructions.
